We are excited to announce the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Borden County Lady Coyote Big Sister-Little Sister Mentor Basketball Program. Each elementary girl that is interested in this program will be assigned to a high school basketball player. This program is designed to get the younger girls interested in our basketball program and ultimately become better basketball players. It is also designed to allow all our participants to engage in service projects throughout the year. We try to have one service project per month throughout the school year.

On the dates listed above, the high school players will plan a fundamental and skills session and will spend 50 minutes working on individual skills and fundamentals with their "little sister." When the school day is complete, the "little sisters" will make their way to the game gym (they will have time to change clothes and get a quick snack before we start at 3:40) where they will go through a series of skills, fundamentals, and games with the high school players. This is a great way to get the elementary girls excited about our basketball program and also to learn some new skills. Additionally, it allows our high school players the opportunity to see the impact they have on the younger girls and how much these younger girls look up to them. It is a positive learning environment for everyone involved.

The only expense for the elementary students is the cost of a T-shirt (\$15 payable to Creative Inks) that the little sisters can wear to the high school games. We want these elementary kids to know how important they are to this program, and we would love to see them at all the games. While we would love them to come to every game, there will be two games that we will want them at for sure. At those two specified games (to be announced at a date closer to the season), we will have the "little sisters" announced before the varsity girls' game and run onto the court with the high school players.

If you are interested in your child becoming a "little sister" to one of our Lady Coyote basketball players for the upcoming 2019-2020 season and would like them to be involved in our Big Sister-Little Sister program, please fill out the following information and waiver and send back to reserve your spot. Some extra information that might help with questions: We realize that you might not be able to make it to every date listed. That is perfectly understandable. Also, please understand that we will need someone there to pick up your child BY 4:30. The high school girls will still have cross country to run before trying to get to church that evening. Please don't request which

“big sister” your child will get. We will assign, and everyone will get help and instruction no matter who their partner is. Your child’s T-shirt will be personalized with your child’s last name on the back and the “big sister’s” basketball number on the back as well. It is always impressive to see all these elementary girls at the games wearing their shirts in support of the team. The service projects that we will participate in will be announced at various times throughout the year. We try to do one service project a month.
